Practical informationHow to dress? What to wear?

To fully enjoy your Patagonian experience, we invite you to read our recommendations on the type of clothing to wear.

In Patagonia, the weather is very changeable: It is not uncommon to experience all four seasons in a single day, or in just a few hours. Summer (December to March) is not very hot, with temperatures averaging 16 degrees Celsius. It can also be rainy and windy, with summer being the season of the strongest winds (over 80 km/h).

Therefore, to enjoy your rides, it is key to have adequate clothing. We recommend synthetic, quick-drying clothing and avoid cotton and jeans: if they get wet, they keep the body cold and take a long time to dry.





Estancia Day

On this beautiful tour we will enjoy beautiful landscapes to get to know in depth the vast territory of Estancia Cerro Guido. Our ride is designed for riders with or without previous experience, who want to experience Patagonia on horseback and discover the natural beauty offered by the surroundings of the Estancia, with its spectacular views of Lake Sarmiento, Sierra Baguales and the Paine Massif, surrounded by animals such as Guanacos, rheas, foxes horses and sheep. After our horseback ride through the amazing landscapes of the Estancia, we will have lunch at the hotel restaurant, with its unique local preparations.

After lunch, our visit begins in the living room of the administration house, with a half-hour introduction to locate ourselves on the map of the area and understand the life of Estancia within the historical context of Patagonia, strongly linked to the development of the extensive sheep farming. Later we will be participants in the typical activities of the Estancia life.

In the mangers we will have the opportunity to learn more about the horses and thei care, then in the organic garden, we will harvest the vegetables used in the kitchen and collect eggs from free-range chickens.

Estancia Cultural Tour

Our guided tour is an invitation to discover an authentic patagonian ranch, where not only the original buildings with valuable testimonies of the region's architectural heritage have been preserved, but also the traditional lifestyle that defines the very essence of Patagonia. This tour through the center of the ranch, founded more than 100 years ago, is a true journey through time.

We start with the presentation of the map of the province and a historical introduction to the cattle activity in Patagonia. After that, we walk through different areas of the ranch, such as the orchard and the greenhouse, where we can try some of their products to finally visit the manor house and the shearing shed if the season allows it.



Lunch & Cultural day

The excursion begins with a warm welcome and a delicious lunch at the estancia's restaurant, where the flavors of the region and homemade cooking blend to provide a memorable culinary experience.

After lunch, the guided cultural tour begins, taking visitors through various historic sites on the estancia. The first stop is a visit to the traditional buildings, dating back to the early 20th century. These carefully preserved structures tell the story of the estancia's origins as one of the first large sheep ranches in the region and its role in the lives of the local people.

The tour continues with a walk through the garden. Here, visitors can learn about the organic farming techniques used to grow a variety of plants, from vegetables to aromatic herbs, and discover how the land has been cultivated for generations.

The last stop of the tour is the shearing shed, where the shearing of the sheep that inhabit the estancia takes place, and where visitors will learn about the wool process.

Reservation, Payment and Cancellation Policies

The reservation must be prepaid by paying 50% of the total amount of the service.

The remaining 50% (balance) must be paid a maximum of 72 hours prior to the day of the service.

Cancellations up to 72 hours prior to the day of the service will be free of charge.
